

## GRAMPIAN CLUB 2024 DAY MEETS PROGRAMME

Date	Venue	Route Options
January 20 (Sat)	Glenshee (Spittal and ski centre hills)	The option of a traverse from the Ski Centre to the Spittal. Or you can enjoy a round of Munros from either base, including the Glas Tulaichean hills and the Glas Maol circuit
February 18 (Sun)	Tyndrum (Dalrigh/Crianlarich hills)	Ben Lui is the jewel in the crown in this area but there are plenty of good neighbours close by and drop-offs are possible for the Crianlarich hills.
March 16 (Sat)	Monadh Liath (Newtonmore and Kingussie)	A round of three Munros are on the lonely landscape above Newtonmore, or why not tackle Carn Dearg from the unusual southern route? There a few good Corbetts and Grahams as an alternative.
April 14 (Sun)	Arrochar Alps	An expedition to the Arrochar Alps, with options including Ben Vorlich, Ben Ime and Ben Vane as well as the opportunity to go through the eye of the needle and summit The Cobbler.
May 18 (Sat) – Long Day	Glenfinnan (Corryhully /Gulvain/Streap etc)	This long day meet offers the chance to tackle the Munros of the Corryhully Horseshoe or the magnificent lone Gulvain, as well as plenty of Corbetts options including Streap
June 15 (Sat) – Long Day	Southern Cairngorms (Inverey /Linn o’ Dee).	Plenty of time to enjoy the big routes in from Linn of Dee or Invervey on this long day meet, with the likes of the Ben Macdui and Derry Cairngorm circuits particularly appealing
September 14 (Sat) – Long Day	Grey Corries/Glen Nevis traverse	An opportunity to traverse the classic Grey Corries ridge over to Glen Nevis, or take on some of the Mamore Munros or even head up The Ben itself
October 20 (Sun)	Black Mount (Victoria Bridge Munros)	Victoria Bridge is the start point for a range of Munros including Stob Ghabhar, as well as a fine selection of Corbetts and Grahams.
November 16 (Sat)	Lochnagar	A choice of routes to one of our finest mountains – from Keiloch on Deeside, or a traverse over the White Mounth peaks from Auchallater in Glen Clunie
December 15 (Sun)	Locheearnhead	Ben Vorlich and Stuc a' Chroin are the main attraction, whether tackled as a walk through from the shores of Loch Lubnaig or from the north near Loch Earn
