DAY MEETS – 2025

by bus from Dundee & Perth

Sat 18 th Jan	CRIANLARICH : This area provides a varied clutch of Munros including the Ben More and Stob Binnein pairing, or the Cruach Ardrain group
Sun 16 th Feb	TROSSACHS : This area provides some excellent walking with Ben Ledi and Ben Vane being highlights, and also a wide variety of lower routes
Sat 15 th Mar	BLAIR ATHOLL : Beautiful Glen Tilt is the gateway to many fine walks, including Carn a' Chlamain and the Corbett Beinn Meadhonach
Sun 13 th Apr	BRIDGE OF ORCHY : This area offers a huge choice of Munros and Corbetts, including Beinn Dòrain and Beinn an Dòthaidh
Sat 17 th May	GLENCOE : Iconic Glencoe presents the chance to tackle some of Scotland's finest mountains such as Buachaille Etive Mor and Bidean nam Bian and also allowing shorter walks such as the Lost Valley
Sat 14 th Jun	NORTHERN CAIRNGORMS : A chance to explore the northern peaks and corries of this fine massif, plus plenty of long and short trails
Sat 20 th Sept	BEN CRUACHAN : Options include the four Munros above Loch Awe plus the superb Corbett Beinn a' Bhuiridh
Sun 19 th Oct	GLENSHEE : Plenty of choice on both sides of the ski road, plus a chance for a high-level traverse from the Ski Centre to The Spittal
Sat 15 th Nov	KILLIN : The seven Munros on the ridge above Loch Tay plus the Tarmachan Ridge are possibilities, with some shorter options available
Sun 14 th Dec	GLEN ESK : Mount Keen is the favourite in this area however there are other options for a high circuit of Loch Lee into Glen Effock
